

It's that simple.

To view the downloaded YouTube videos (which are in .FLV format) on your PC I recommend you use VLC Media Player . Download it FREE at www.videolan.org/vlc/

If your mp4 player plays .FLV files just transfer to your player and you can watch the videos wherever you are. I have an [ONDA mp4 player](#) , which is a great little player and supports .FLV files , so you dont need to mess around converting your downloaded YouTube videos.

If your mp4 player doesnt support .FLV files you're going to have to convert them to a format that will work on your player.

Heres a decent .FLV convertor you can try :
